The Four Categories



Promote Efficient and Electric Buildings

O1 ENERGY ASSESSMENTS*

Access a list of eligible building efficiency improvements.
All customers are eligible; no-cost to customers.

04 LED LIGHTING

Residents can call HMLP for one free LED light bulb per account. Commercial customer rebate is 50% of project up to \$4,000.

O2 WEATHERIZATION*

Create a tight envelope to conserve energy resources. 50% of project up to \$1,000 annually; air sealing or insulation.

05 APPLIANCES

Save money with EnergyStar appliances. The HMLP program is up to \$200 in annual rebates; \$500 for hot water heat pumps.

O3 HEATING & COOLING*

Decarbonize buildings with electric heat pumps. \$750/ton up to \$4,500 with a \$500 weatherization adder & \$1,000 whole-home adder.

Promote Transportation Electrification

01 BUYING ELECTRIC

Use the Drive & Save Wizard at no-cost to research & compare electric vehicle options. https://hmlp.wattplan.com/ev/

02 AT-HOME CHARGING

Level-2 WiFi capable chargers are reccomended for home use. \$300 for eligible chargers.

03 OFF-PEAK CHARGING

Charge during the evening to get a monthly HMLP bill credit of \$5 or \$10, depending on charger.

04 PUBLIC CHARGING

Public stations are located around Hingham. Download the FLO app or any charging map to see where the stations are.

05 EXPANDING NETWORKS

Commercial customers are eligible to apply for up to \$6,000 to install stations.



Expand Energy Generation and Storage

O1 SOLAR ARRAYS

Reduce personal consumption of energy by installing solar. \$0.60/W up to 10 kW (\$6,000).

O2 BATTERY STORAGE*

Choose when to discharge energy and when to store it. *program coming soon*

O3 DEMAND RESPONSE*

Allow for HMLP to respond to peaks, keep power on & cheap. *program coming soon*

04 NET METERING

Get money for sending excess solar energy back into the grid. This rate is based on the market.

05 REDUCE CONSUMPTION

Combine energy efficiency with generation to reach net-zero.
